**SUBJECT:** Restoring Continuing Medical Education (CME) for  
Component Society Meeting Attendance

1 **Whereas**, many Michigan Osteopathic Association (MOA) component societies have  
2 experienced a significant multi-year decline in member participation; and

3 **Whereas**, the ability to achieve goals established by the osteopathic profession in  
4 Michigan requires effective communication between Michigan Osteopathic Association  
5 (MOA) and its component societies; and

6 **Whereas**, the component societies have scheduled membership meetings throughout  
7 the year which have characteristically been poorly attended; and

8 **Whereas**, American Osteopathic Association (AOA) policy only allows earning category  
9 1A continuing medical education credit (CME) in face to face medical education lecture,  
10 coordinated with the approved governing organization.

11 **Therefore, Be it Resolved**, that the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) consider  
12 modifying its policy to permit granting category 1A continuing medical education credit  
13 for a component society general membership meeting which has an appropriate face to  
14 face speaker educational program.
